TV Programmer: Great! My first question is about personality. How can we understand a person is shy or outgoing?

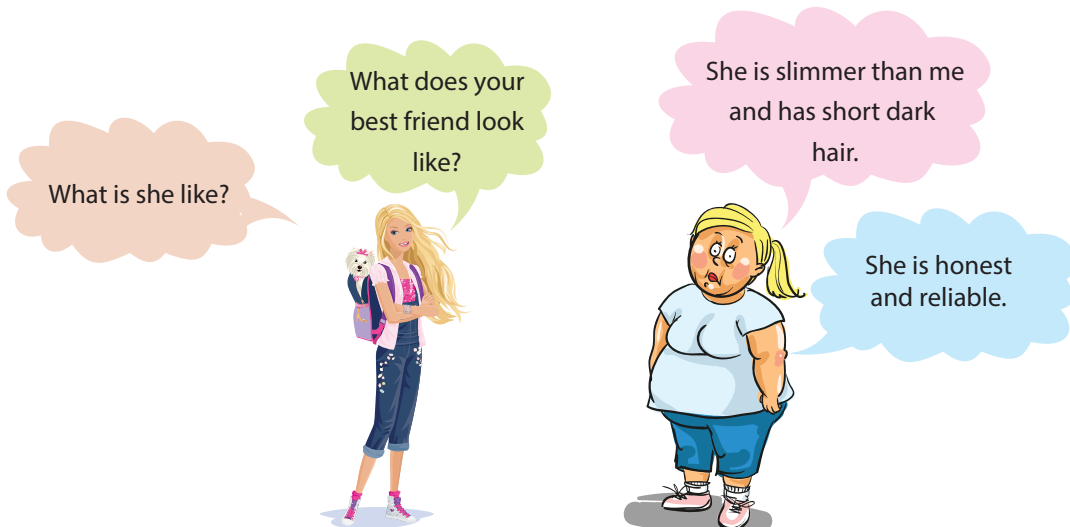
